TWO YEARS POST GRADUATE PROGRAMME (Self-Financed) SESSION 2026-27

Entrance Tests for admission to the **Two-year** Postgraduate Programmes (with **Coursework and Research**) in **Political Science** and **Sociology** for the 2026-27 session at Jagannath Barooah University are scheduled to be held on **21.07.2026 (11:00 am to 1:00 pm)** in the university's **main campus**.

However, no Entrance test will be conducted for admission into **the Two-year** Postgraduate Programmes (with **Coursework and Research**) for the following subjects.

One Year Post Graduate Diploma Programmes (Session: 2026-2027):

Post Graduate Diploma in Computer Application (**PGDCA**)

All candidates interested in admission into the Two-years Post Graduate Programmes (Course Work and Research) in Jagannath Barooah University, with or without entrance test in any subject, must apply through the Assam SAMARTH admission portal:

Candidates interested in admission into the One year Post Graduate Programmes in PGDCA and PGDGI in Jagannath Barooah University, must also apply through the Assam SAMARTH admission portal:

Eligibility:

1. Candidate must have studied the subject in which s/he seeks admission at the PG level either as a UG Major or Minor subject.
2. In Major, s/he must have secured 50% average in the UG Programme or, in case of Minor, s/he must have secured 55% average in his/her UG programme
3. Candidate who are awaiting results after appearing in their 6th / final semester of the UG programme are also eligible to apply based on his/her performance in up to the penultimate semester.

Admission Process:

- **Entrance Test:** Admission to **M.A. in Sociology** and **M.A. in Political Science** will be through entrance examinations conducted by the respective departments. Candidates must appear for the entrance test in person at the main campus of the University. The application process for **appearing in the entrance test must be completed** through the online portal available at <https://jbcollege.curioversity.com> on or before 19th July 2026.
- **Direct Merit-Based Admission:** For all other PG and diploma programmes, selection will be based on the percentage of marks obtained in the respective subject in the UG examination. No separate entrance test will be held for these subjects.

Note:

- Application fee (non-refundable) of ₹ 500 (Rupees five hundred only) for **Entrance Test in Political Science and Sociology** must be paid at <https://jbcollege.curioversity.com>
- A maximum gap of **two academic years** will be permitted, subject to submission of a valid **Gap Certificate** issued by a competent authority or a **Court Affidavit**.
- Candidates who have appeared in the final UG examination and are awaiting results are also eligible to apply and appear in the entrance examination (if applicable). However, if selected, their admission will be provisional and subject to securing the required qualifying marks and submission of the pass certificate/marksheet at the time of final admission.
