

## SELECTION PROCEDURE FOR HONOURS PROGRAMME:

### i) **B.A. Honours Programme –**

- Students passed in 10+2 examination in ARTS in 2019 and 2020 with an aggregate of 45% marks may apply for **B. A. Honours Programme** in subjects mainly **Assamese, Economics, English, Hindi, History, Geography, Philosophy, Political Science, Sanskrit and Sociology**. Students with Mathematics at the 10+2 level be preferred for **Economics** Honours.
- Students passed in 10+2 examination in Science and Commerce in 2019 and 2020 with an aggregate of 45% marks may also apply for **B. A. Honours Programme** in subjects **Assamese, Economics, English and Hindi** only studied in 10+2.
- Subject selected for Honours should be studied by the students at the 10+2 level.
- Merit list will be prepared on the basis of total marks secured in the 10+2 examination plus marks secured in the subject to be taken as Honours.

### ii) **B.Sc. Honours Programme –**

- Students passed in 10+2 examination in Science in 2019 and 2020 with an aggregate of 45% marks may apply for **B. Sc. Honours Programme**.
- **However, students must note that the selection criteria for B.Sc. Honours Programme vary according to subjects as given below;**
- Students opting for **Honours in Chemistry and Physics** must have studied Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics at the 10+2 level. The Merit List for these subjects will be prepared on the basis of total marks secured in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics plus marks secured in the subject to be taken as Honours.
- Students opting for **Honours in Geology, Electronic Science** must have studied Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics at the 10+2 level. The Merit List for these subjects will be prepared on the basis of total marks secured in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics.
- Students opting for **Honours in Botany and Zoology** must have studied Physics, Chemistry and Biology at the 10+2 level. The Merit List for these subjects will be prepared on the basis of total marks secured in Physics, Chemistry and Biology plus marks secured in Biology.
- Students opting for **Honours in Mathematics and Statistics** must have studied **EITHER** Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics **OR** Economics, Statistics and Mathematics at the 10+2 level. The Merit List for these subjects will be prepared on the basis of total marks secured in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics **OR** Economics, Statistics and Mathematics.

### iii) **B. Com. Honours Programme –**

- Students passed in 10+2 examination in Commerce in 2019 and 2020 with an aggregate of 45% marks may apply for **B. Com. Honours Programme**.
- Merit list will be prepared on the basis of total marks secured in English, Accountancy and Business Studies at the 10+2 examination.
